

Ruminations

This past week has been so wonderful. Despite the multitude of funerals, it has been such a gift to be able to get all the yard work, well, most of the yard work done. There is still a garden bed at the entrance that has remained mostly untouched all summer and will likely remain that way until the spring. I was out in shorts and a tee shirt at 6:30 in the morning bagging the last piles of leaves in the backyard and front of the church, and it was such a feeling of exhilaration finishing just as the sun was rising. My garlic is planted and all the trees and shrubs that needed it received their last thorough drink of water before the ground freezes. Winter can do its best now. I came in and checked my emails and saw a note from my dentist's office inquiring whether or not I was ready at this time to rebook my teeth cleaning and my pending dental work to fill a cavity. It was an interesting way of posing the question. Am I ever prepared to go to the dentist? One of my irrational phobias is going to the dentist. It always has been, probably because the first time I went, many years ago and climbed those stairs to Dr. Sedore's office in Aurora and was met by the wonderful smile of his assistant Edie, who had gone to school with mom, and being poked and prodded to find 4 cavities that were filled with the torturous sound of the drill and the smell of burning enamel. I'm not too sure why I have this acquired, long standing fear of the dental office. It is a bit perplexing because most of the time there are no issues, no drilling, no burning enamel, and only the pleasant monotony of the fish in the aquarium swimming to and fro as I recline in the chair looking up. Now I do have to admit that as I get older, that sustained reclining does induce a bit of light headedness as gravity encourages the blood to flow to the head, but usually when they tell me no problems, the fog dissipates and is replaced by an euphoric relief. And as I gather at the counter to book the next appointment, the dread begins to mount again. So when the pandemic presented the opportunity to postpone the fear-laden exercise, I jumped at the chance to put off the inevitable. To be truthful, it was not a function of fear of the virus. So when the email arrived reminding me that at some time I would have to face the reality of good dental hygiene, I got a pit in my stomach. The rational thing to do is to muster the courage to do what must be done and overcome the irrational fear of avoiding that which is good for me. And if I were completely honest with myself, I do believe that there is an issue with one of my teeth and feels like there is a root canal in my future, the very near future. So as we remember



all those soldiers who fought so valiantly to ensure our freedom and prosperity, in a weird way, maybe one way of respecting their sacrifice is to avail myself of the freedoms and services that they died to ensure we could have. Buck up and call the dentist. In my way it will be in honour of the heart of remembrance. Happy Remembrance Day.
