

#### Easter Did You Know

Did you know...

That Easter can only occur between March 22 and April 25 based on the rhythm of the Moon

Most countries use a variation of Paschal to refer to Easter, but the English word is derived from an ancient Anglo-Saxon goddess of Spring, Eostre. Another theory is it comes from an old German word for East.

It is believed that an Italian baker made the first pretzel to resemble the folded arms of someone praying, sometime between the years 300 - 600 ad.

Easter Islands were so named because the first Europeans encountered them on Easter Sunday, 1722 and named is Paasch-Eyland, old Dutch for Easter Island.

One of the most popular Easter hymns, "Jesus Christ is Risen today" was composed by Protestant Methodist leader, Charles Wesley'.

The various moments of Easter, the suffering, death, resurrection, ascension, and sending of the Holy Spirit, what we call the Paschal Mystery, were celebrated as a single event called Easter.
