#### **Ruminations** ....

Like most people, one of those weekly chores is putting out the recycling. We have a special vehicle that comes usually early Thursday mornings. They drive up to the side of the hall, by the kitchen door where our array of recycling bins, cardboard boxes, and spent plastic candle sleeves are ready to be lifted into the van and hauled away. Another weekly task is preparing the bulletin. It is quite the production. Kind of an unwritten rule is that an announcement should be repeated for at least three weeks to ensure that 90% of the readers have a chance to glance at it. Since the pandemic, we have moved to an On-line Bulletin. Before the pandemic, the bulletin had to be submitted to the printing company who ran it off and then shipped the completed bulletins to us for distribution. One time they accidently shipped us the bulletins for a parish in St. Catharine's. I assume they received ours. Upon reading their bulletin, I decided we were a better parish. The old timeline meant we had very strict deadlines, and very strict capacities in terms of the number of pages that could be printed, colour as an option, and inevitably there was always extras for recycling. If we wanted more information in the bulletin, it meant we would need to create inserts in the office and spend time stuffing the inserts into the bulletins. It was kind of tedious. Now we can include as many pages as necessary. Coloured graphics can be included, and we have no waste bulletins for the recycling bins. This flexibility in time however, instigates some bad habits. We can now hold off finishing the bulletin until Thursday morning. Now the publishers aren't very keen on this, but sometimes the busyness of parish life makes it difficult to abide by the earlier regimented timeframe. And let's face it, creativity in ruminating cannot be rushed. For instance, for some reason, all the creativity had been jolted from my brain. No matter how long I sat in front of the computer, the page remained blank for hours. Necessity dictated that the bulletin be sent Wednesday afternoon, and no matter how much I was harangued, nothing was germinating. So provisions were being made for me to deliver the electronic bulletin on Thursday morning. Apparently we are identified as parish 207. They needed to be informed that we were having 5 extra pages this week, and I needed to send it in two formats. They needed to receive it before lunch so that the proper sponsors page could be added, the content vetted, and then it sent to the Archdiocese to be up-loaded onto our website. The truth be told, I think the bulletin is actually accessible by close of work day on Thursday, or maybe early Friday morning. That is long before we send out the notice and link at 10:15 am

Saturday morning. There are a few people who ask us for a hard copy of the bulletin which we are able to do, but for the most part, we have more bulletins sent out and opened than we ever had when we had the paper copies. Besides, think of how many trees we have saved with modern technology. Check out the bulletin. Fr. Roy




