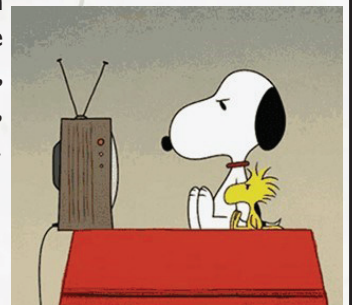

I kind of doubt it. It does call to mind though, a John Prine novelty song, "Blow up your tv's, throw away your papers, move to the country... try to find Jesus, all on your own."
