



After the Mass the two schools headed back to their own school gyms for a dance until 9:30, and we were warned that we had to dance with either our moms or our dads. As teenage boys, it was kind of weird but it had to be done. My mom told me I had to ask my aunt to dance. My cousin was in my class. I'm not sure if he danced with my mom. My parents were not that happy with me. I had convinced them that none of the other boys would be wearing a suit and tie, so I got away with wearing a new short sleeve orange dress shirt purchased for this auspicious occasion. Oops, all the other boys were in suits. I didn't care, I was comfortable. The parents stayed as chaperones and when the last song played, we all just gathered in in circle reflecting that this would be the last time we were all together, most of us who had been together since kindergarten. Most of those classmates, it was indeed the last time we have encountered each other. But the best of the day was still to come. When we arrived home, my brothers and the baby sitter had decorated the kitchen with a cake and balloons, and home made congratulation signs, and there was a big, wrapped gift in the middle of the table. As I started to open it, dad called the three brothers down from bed and I opened my graduation gift, a new


