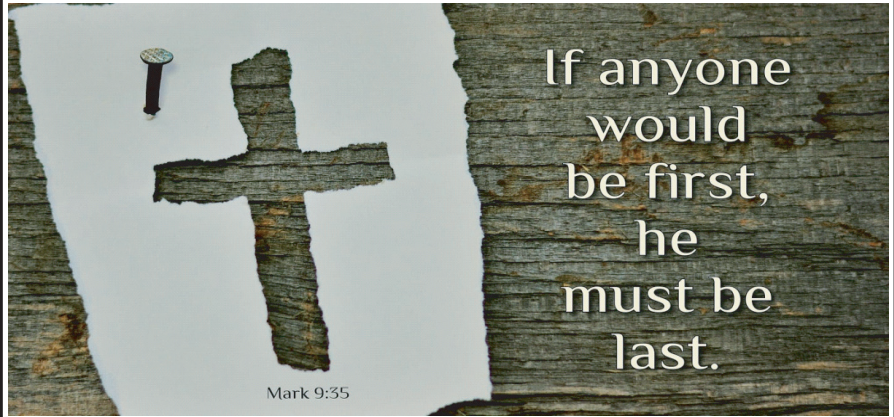

Ruminations

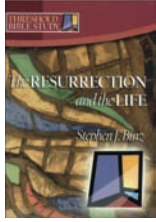
A few years ago, well, scarily, maybe almost a decade ago, it just seems like a few, I visited a doctor of Chinese medicine. I vividly recall one of his diagnoses, when he spoke those immortal word, "You are hot." Okay, I know what he was trying to say, but I prefer my interpretation. Along with those words, he went on to surmise that my vacation preferences would not be found in southern beaches and sand, but in the coolness of mountains and woods. I was impressed that he nailed that. From the first time I went skiing in Banff, I knew that I had an affinity for mountains and forests, the wilderness and running streams, and mountain waterfalls. So when my nephew had a job interview in Calgary, I jumped at the opportunity to travel to Calgary once again. My last visit had been in 1992, shortly after the Winter Olympics and a highlight was visiting the Olympic venues, especially the speed skating arena. I did learn that no matter how much hockey I had played, using speed skates was a humbling experience. Anyway, it was going to be a whirlwind of a trip and I wasn't sure we would have an opportunity to drive out to see the mountains close up. The flight was uneventful, and when we arrived in Calgary, we found the shuttle to the rental car place without a problem. The first glitch, if you really call it that, was sitting in the car ready to head through the highways and roads to the hotel in south Calgary. It had no stick shift to put the car into gear. It has a dial – a turning dial that just turned the mechanism for reverse or drive. Sounds simple enough, but it was kind of unnerving. I got the car into gear and slowly backed out. As I was checking around and paused a bit, the car stalled, or at least that is what seemed to happen. It popped into my head that I would need to go in and exchange this lemon that stalled in the driveway, but my nephew chuckled and explained it is a new thing, that the car will 'stall' but as soon as you give it some gas, the starts up again. Let's just say, I never got used to it; it created a mini-panic every time it happened, and when the time comes for a new vehicle, I do not want such a thing. For an outsider not accustomed to the streets of Calgary, it was mind-boggling, and I suppose we weren't there long enough to discover their logic, if there is indeed one. The big interview was an hour and a half in the middle of the afternoon, but when he finished, we decided that to come all this way and not see the mountains close up would be a lost opportunity, so we set the cell phone navigator, and diligently followed her instructions, merges, turns, change lanes, and we made good time. If you have never seen the horizon from Calgary, the mountains are mystical and magical. We didn't have a lot of time to explore Banff and Lake Louise, but the drive to and through the mountains was already worth the price of admission. Our priority was to have dinner there but not stay too late. I didn't fancy driving in the dark in unfamiliar places – as my nephew remarked, "that's a typical old person's reaction." I told him one more comment like that and he was out of the will. We found out later in the week that he was not being called back for the next stage of the interview process. I originally thought that it was too far from home, but after seeing the mountains, I could have accepted that fate. Anyway, it was a great outing – a bit too short, but it was a great trip.

It's that Time of the Year **Registrations for First Communion & Confirmation**

For those young people who are in at least Grade 2 are eligible to register for First Communion next Easter Season. Those young people in at least Grade 7 are eligible to enroll in preparations to celebrate Confirmation around Pentecost next Spring. **Registration forms will be available starting the weekend of September 1st. The last date for registration is Sunday, September 29th after the 11:00 am Mass.**

The registration form must be accompanied by a Catholic baptism certificate. Children in the Public School or who are home schooled will need to participate in Sacramental Preparation. Registration is for children who worship with us each week. If you belong to another parish, check with them for their requirements. The Sacraments are celebrated in the parish where you worship/belong, not in the parish where the school is located. Children who are not baptized or were baptized in a non-Catholic denomination must see either Jennifer or Fr. Roy before submitting the registration forms.


