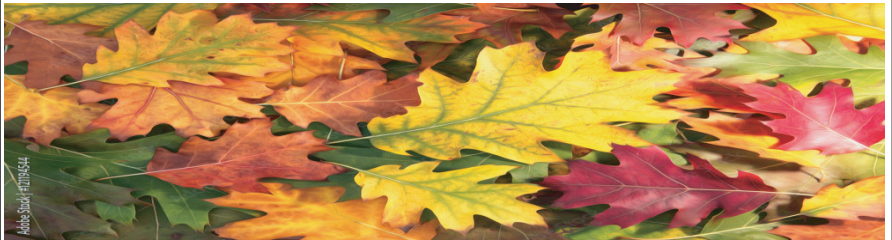

Ruminations

It has been at least 25 years since the venue for our annual priests' retreat in May, and annual conference in October has been at Nottawasaga Inn in Alliston. In the early years the retreat was held at the seminary with the young priests were housed across the field at Scarboro Foreign Missions. WE young priests had to brave the spring weather to trudge on over to the Seminary for the talks and meals – great memories- not of the housing with one washroom for twenty priests, but just remembering being a 'young priest'. Looking around at the menagerie assembled here, there aren't too many more senior than me, including the Cardinal-elect archbishop. As the numbers increased, it was hard to find a place that could accommodate the numbers facilities we would need. MY suggestion of Banff Springs hotel in Banff was summarily rejected, alas. After stints at Collingwood's Cranberry Inn, and Barrie's Holiday Inn, finally Nottawasaga worked, especially after the renovations. It is nice that it is relatively close so that if I need to scoot back to collect a phone charging cord that I forgot, or needed to make sure the recycling is out, or to cover the gardens beds in Spring for fear of frost, it is entirely possible. This year I had to take an early morning jaunt to Our Lady of Grace in Aurora. Last week I was on duty with the hospital beeper. Tuesdays are the transfer day but I had arranged with the priests there to drop it off on Monday on my way to Alliston. Well, that kind of fell through and so I had to take it with me. Late Monday afternoon, it went off twice. The first call wanted to know if I needed my ducts cleaned. The second call, the person tried to engage me in pleasantries. I told him that he had just called an emergency hospital beeper and that unless someone was dying at his end of the line... Good manners prevent me from revealing the rest of the conversation. So, after a dine and dash breakfast at 6:30 am, I jumped in my car to take the beeper to Aurora so I could get back in time for the first session. The sun wasn't even peeking over the horizon which meant that as I was speeding down the 400 highway, well, to be honest, there was so much traffic that in my younger years, I could have rode my bike faster. Anyway, it took over an hour to get there. I kept lamenting on behalf of commuters who have to do this every day, but as the sun slowly arose, the autumn colours were magical. It was such a glorious sight all the way down the road. I didn't mind the slow pace. The golds seemed more golden in the early morning sun, and the reds more vibrant. When I arrived at the church, the Office wasn't yet open, and the priest was at the altar celebrating Mass. I kind of wanted to walk up and leave it on his chair, but instead I tried to fit it through the office mail slot figuring they would find it in due time. Anyway, if it went off, I wouldn't know about it. Out of sight out of mind. I headed back north and made much better time travelling against traffic. In forty minutes, I was back just in time for the first session. In truth, I'm not so sure it would have been a tremendous loss if I was late. Anyway, as they say, timing is everything, in the rising of the sun, in the quiet revealing of the fall colours, and in catching the wisdom or at least enthusiasm of the presenters.
