# **Ruminations** ....

It feels funny referring to mom's possessions as an 'estate'. Mom and dad would have both laughed heartedly at the notion. There was no great accumulation of wealth or portfolios. There was the time when the trucking firm that dad worked for offered company stocks and my parents bought in for a small amount, more like a savings option for Christmas. When the company went belly up and they lost their money, that was the end of any formal attempts at playing the stock market. Every time mom and dad sat down to try to devise a budget, something dastardly would happen and that would be the end of that. The only real investment they ever pursued was an investment in our family, a comfortable house, reliable transportation, and of course, hockey, hockey, hockey. For a couple of years, mom had been bugging us to get her will and powers of attorney done, but summer would come, and the lawyer was more involved in real estate transactions so we would put it off. Finally, the time was right and we sat down with our lawyer. At the time, we really didn't suspect that dementia was well underway. Mom insisted that her bank account become a joint account, and looking back, I think she knew the gig was up. A week to the day that mom signed all the documents, we had our first real indication that mom's cognitive functions were waning. We got a call from some lady who was sitting with mom at a Tim Horton's at 10:30 at night in Elora, Ontario. Mom had run out of gas. Well, she didn't bring her purse, or driver's license or wallet. Mom would not have a clue where Elora is or how to get there, and she started with a full tank of gas, so we are not quite sure how long she had been driving or where she had been driving. That was the last time mom drove a car. For months afterward, it was the source of a lot of family jokes, and even mom, in her saner moments, which were becoming fewer and fewer, recognized the absurdity of it. She declined pretty quickly until it was necessary to move her to a place where she could be kept safe and provided for all the time. There was time with me, but she got lost twice and there was no way to monitor her 24/7. When she took up residence at Bradford Valley after being on a crisis admissions list for three weeks, we arranged to sell her house and create an investment to provide for her needs. Again, this account was a joint account. She knew that it would just make things easier in the end. So with mom's passing, there is nothing to probate which has made life so easy. Most of her affairs are tied up and we are just waiting to file her final income tax. As I keep reminding my brothers though, her bank account and her investments are now in my name, and although mom's wishes are well known to all of us, don't they say possession is 9/10's of the law. I have told them that just because I get a new car (which I am not getting) or go on an exotic vacation (not going to happen) it has nothing to do with mom's 'estate'. Mom would be so thrilled knowing that her and dad's efforts have given their children a bit of a windfall. Thanks mom and dad. A word to the wise, as in life, so in death, mom and dad where very uncomplicated people and so make sure your powers of attorney, and wills, and plans are up to date, otherwise it may be like my friend who has taken over 4 years of headaches to settle her mom's estate.


