Ruminations

Perhaps it is part because I have my car parked in a garage and so I don't generally have to scrape my windows or clear the snow off my car, or perhaps it is because we have a service who ensures the parking lot and sidewalks are cleared of snow, and it is a rare occasion that I need to pick up a shovel and clear a path, or perhaps it is because there is no pressing need for me to venture out on slick roads; whatever the reason, I have truly been enjoying the big flakes of snow during our recent manifestation of winter. It reminded me so much of being out west in the mountains at Whistler. I had traveled out there for almost ten years in a row with some priest friends, and almost everyday we awoke to big piles of snow mounds capping the tops of cars and lamp posts, and it was exciting and invigorating. Some of the runs were absolutely breath-taking, and scenery was magical, and getting older and out of shape, the length of those slopes also took your breath away, but that was more about gasping for air and suffering lactic acid build-up in the legs. I was usually the first of us to leave the hill each day. Part of it was conditioning, and part of it was my wide feet and high instep. My ski boots never fit properly, and it would become too painful to ski. When I took my boots off for the day, sometimes there were open wounds across the top of my feet, so I didn't mind heading in early. It afforded me some personal time in the apartment which was otherwise a bit crowded with the four of us. I would usually spend time reading my annual John Grisham novel, and I would go into the swimming pool. It was neat because the pool was outside and there is noting like soaking in the warm water while the snow is falling, and the wet hair sitting about the water would freeze. Big flakes falling on your face and relaxing with a cup of hot chocolate was almost as good as the slopes. Now it is hard to compare the landscape of York Region with the mountains of Whistler. The elevation-drop down Davis Drive hardly constitutes a ski run, but I have always imagined the long and winding road into Holland Landing as potential. That road has always been a favorite spot. On a beautiful fall day, with the trees ablaze in their autumn glory, there is no better place. This week I had the chance to drive down the road and the trees were all coated with a delicious covering of snow, like icing on a cake. Every tree, every branch glistened and sparkled in the sun. It was a magical winter wonderland. It was one of those scenes when you



wished you had a camera. Well, being of that generation, I forgot that I did have a camera - on my phone. Chances are, the camera would never have been able to capture the magic of this perfect winter scene. Maybe I will just have to fly to Whistler to find another perfect winter day.
