

Ruminations

Mom died almost three months ago, and there are a lot of little hoops that need to be jumped through. Perhaps the most aggravating ones are - brace yourself- dealing with the Government. I called and informed several of the Government Departments that my mother was now deceased and therefore, do not send her any of the monies, supplemental income, or rebates. Of course, the Old Age Pension stopped immediately, which in the long run was fine. Shortly around the two month mark of her passing, a check came in the mail for her. Part of me wanted to say, thank you very much, I informed you, and silly on you for sending it, but the saner part of me knew that eventually it would come back to haunt me. I don't know if it is considered fraud or what, but the reality is, I'm too pretty for prison. I called the number on the cheque and after an exorbitant amount of waiting and listening to an annoying musical interlude that kept going on and on and repeating itself, I was instructed how to rectify the mistake. I mailed it back to the Government with proof of death and a letter of explanation with pertinent information like her social insurance number. It felt a bit funny, finalizing mom as a person in the Government systems and rendering her a 'statistic', but such is the circle of life. Low and behold, another cheque arrived a few weeks later and the urge to cash it because it was their fault now grew quite strong, but once again, being a dutiful citizen and a more dutiful son, I inquired how to return it. Again, more boring soundtracks on the Government waiting line and back went the cheque. Another moment that occurred this week, and you have to remember as I have admitted before, I am rather obsessed with numbers. This week will mark my dad's twenty-first anniversary of his passing, exactly 80 days shy of his 65th birthday. I remember the occasion when dad surpassed the longevity of his own father who died at age 58. That milestone then created a new unofficial target, his 65th, that was the source of a lot of humour and jokes in our household. Dad had been sick for many years and that date would have been regarded as an unattainable date, which it turned out to be. Well, this week I have officially lived longer than my father, and to top it off, the Government sent me information all about my 'Old Age Pension' or what they call 'Old Age Security'. I remember thinking that people receiving their Old Age Pension were, well, old. For some reason I don't think that anymore, and despite the Government's waffling back and forth about increasing the date before you can receive it, I rather like the idea of the Government giving me money for being alive. In a sense, it is the first time that the Government is affirming my existence. I have plans for that monthly little bonus of income went it starts to flow in, well, it's not really that much, so when it starts to trickle in, but I would like to mark the arrival of the first cheque and do something frivolous



and fun. Part of me was thinking of something wild and crazy like skydiving or the CN Tower walk, or bungee jumping though I have done that. With my dispassion for travel which includes driving more than an hour, the most likely celebration will be to do something radically defiant, like order a large pizza, but with double cheese, double pepperoni, and double bacon. Now there is a celebration worthy of the occasion. Bon Appetit.
