The reading from the book of Wisdom recalls the Exodus, nurturing hope in God's promise. Through remembrance of God's saving plan, the Jewish people's sense of identity as a Chosen People was reaffirmed and reinforced. We are invited to engage with salvation history as an integral part of our own story, allowing it to affirm our identity as beloved and saved children of God.</b></p> <p><b>The reading from the book of Hebrews recalls the faith of our ancestors who received the reward of blessing through an exodus from slavery. It recalls Abraham's unshakeable faith and hope in God's promise. We stand in a long line of witnesses of God's faithful promise. Allow that truth to strengthen your hope in the Lord's fidelity in your life circumstances.</b></p> <p><b>Consciousness of God's fidelity inspires trust in present circumstances. When fear surfaces, we do well to turn to our theological memory of God's promise and fidelity. We recall Jesus' tender words, "Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom" (Luke 12:32). Hope and trust are like beacons of light that casts away lurking shadows of doubt and fear. We keep our lamps lit by exercising these necessary virtues.</b></p> |
