50th Anniversary of the Canonization Of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton

Elizabeth Ann Seton was born to Episcopalian parents into New York City high society on Aug. 28, 1774. After her husband died in 1803, Seton began getting to know the Catholic Church and

converted in 1805. Her conversion unleashed a storm among her Protestant

relatives and friends and made her financial strains even greater.

In 1808 she moved to Baltimore and privately took her first vows. In 1812, Seton became the foundress and first superior of the Sisters of Charity in the United States.

She died in Emmitsburg, Maryland, on Jan. 4, 1821, and was canonized on **Sept. 14, 1975**.

Dear Parishioners:

Re: North of 60 Project Update

I am pleased to report that two sea containers loaded with food items were shipped to two of Canada's northern most Arctic communities in July, Gjoa Haven and Taloyoak.

Without the financial support of all parishioners, this would not have been possible. We sincerely appreciate your continued generosity and commitment to assist indigenous families through our North of 60 Project. Thank you!

St. John Chrysostom / St. Elizabeth Seton Conference together with financial donations from Our Lady of Grace Conference in Aurora and St. Paul the Apostle Conference in Alliston shared the food expense of \$11,202.

We purchased 11,049 pounds of basic food such as flour, sugar, oatmeal, rice, lard and canned meat. These were transported by truck to Markham and included in the containers that were organized by St Patrick's Conference. With St. Patrick's conference organizing the containers and by purchasing whole skid loads of the items, we eliminated most of the manual labour incurred in our previous sea container sent to the arctic.

Sea lanes opened earlier than normal this year and allowed the containers picked up July 15th to be delivered August 15th. The food was promptly transferred into the church and other heated buildings to protect against future freezing temperatures. Families lined up soon afterward to receive needed food items.

September 30, 2025, marks the fifth National Day for truth and Reconciliation. If you are able and choose to donate to this cause, please pick up a special blue NORTH OF 60 PROJECT envelope from the St. Vincent de Paul boxes at the back of the church. Deposit your donation envelope in the St. Vincent de Paul box.


