Installation of New Pastor

Saturday November 1, 2025, His excellency Auxillary Bishop John Boissonneau will be at St. Elizabeth Seton to celebrate Father Roselle's installation as Pastor at the 4:30pm Mass on November 1.

You may be wondering what exactly is an "Installation Mass"?

At his installation mass, the new pastor leads the people in the Profession of Faith, the Nicene Creed. Following the Creed, he makes an Oath of Fidelity in front of the bishop.

With the recitation of the Oath of Fidelity, the bishop of the diocese is assured that the bonds of unity are strengthened between the parish to the diocese and to the Universal Church. The pastor never acts alone. Everything he does in the parish is to be in union with the bishop, who is in union with the Bishop of Rome.

The Oath of Fidelity reinforces that bond and could be seen as a further clarification of what was already promised by the priest on the day of his ordination to the diaconate and priesthood. In both ceremonies, the man being ordained kneels before the ordaining bishop, places his joined hands between those of the bishop and is asked, "Do you promise respect and obedience to me and my successors? The man responds, "I do." And with that freely-given consent, the union between the priest, his bishop, and the Universal Church is established.

The obedience that is given is key to building up the local church.

Throughout the Ordination Rite, the deacon or priest is reminded of the importance of collaborating with the bishop in the work of the diocese, assuring the unity of faith. And so, even though a new pastor has already promised obedience to his bishop twice—at his ordination as a deacon and priest—at his installation, the pastor once again reaffirms that all that he does in the parish will be in union with and in collaboration with the mind and heart of the bishop and ultimately the Supreme Pontiff.

In John 17: 20-26, Jesus prays that His disciples would be one - not just 'getting along' but, living in such, see love and respect that the world would see God through them. Christian unity is more than a nice idea. It's a testimony. It points to the love of the Trinitarian God and the truth of the Gospel of the Lord Jesus.

Without unity, the ancient enemy drives a wedge and we become divided, scattered and vanquished.

Holy Father, we humbly beseech you to accept us also, together with your Son, and in this saving banquet graciously to endow us with his very Spirit, who takes away everything that estranges us from one another. May he make your Church a sign of unity and an instrument of your peace among all people and may he keep us in communion with Leo our Pope and Frank our Bishop and all the Bishops and your entire people. (Eucharistic Prayer for Reconciliation II)

All Parishioners are invited to celebrate Fr. Roselle's Installation following the 4:30pm Mass. Please join us in Seton Hall for a reception.

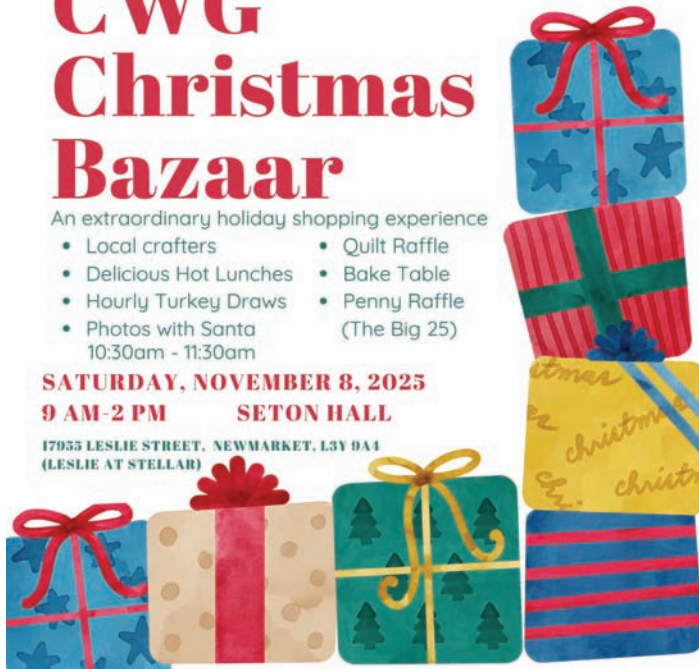

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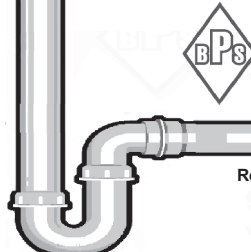
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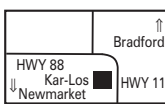
