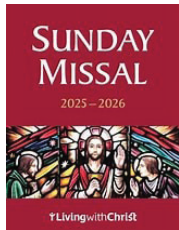

Book of Remembrance

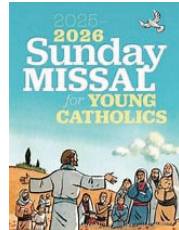
