The Lord Jesus is the most sacred of temples; He is the Temple. Yet He changed. His body suffered the wounds that were inflicted upon his body. Jesus changed interiorly, too. Lord Jesus, your beauty transcends all creation, even my holiest of thoughts. Please bless me with the gift to appreciate more perfectly the limited beauty of created things and the infinite and everlasting beauty of you, my Lord, and my God. Amen.

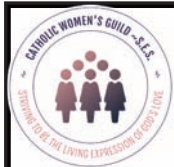


Thank You to Our Student Volunteers!

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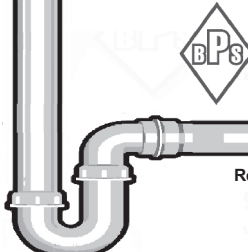
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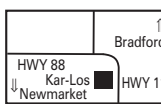
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
