

He wants us to be honest and real, to meet him as we are.

Engage in the Scripture readings of the Advent season. So often, Advent is filled with holiday gatherings and events at school, at work, and with our families and friends. We seem to have a lot of commitments this time of the year that pull us in many different directions. But, God is calling is to be present to him in a special way this time of the year. Blessings to all of you on your Advent journey.




