Christmas in Action

The Feast of our Lord's Baptism is the last day of the Christmas season. In this feast, we see Jesus announces his presence as a mature adult. Some may ask why we end the Christmas season with this feast. What does this day have to do with the familiar scenes of crib, shepherds and the visit of the Magi?

'Epiphany' is the connection between the two events, separated chronologically by a gap of about thirty years. What do we mean by that? In the religious sense, 'Epiphany' means a manifestation or revelation of something from God. In particular, it refers to the Feast of the Epiphany, which we celebrated last Sunday. We celebrated the revelation of the great truth that the Infant Jesus is the divine Son of God, sent to proclaim salvation to all.

The Church celebrates another Epiphany of the Lord today - the feast of the Baptism of Jesus is also an Epiphany. It also reveals to us the divine origin of Jesus as the Son of God. God the Father declares it to us: This is my Son, the Beloved, of whom I am well pleased. Also, the Holy Spirit confirms it in coming down upon Jesus as a dove. Jesus is confirmed for his mission to save us.

Why did Jesus feel the need to be baptised? What was it's significance for his mission? After all, Jesus was without sin, while the baptism by John was a cleansing for sinners. The key to this issue is the dialogue between Jesus and John the Baptist: it is proper for us to fulfill all righteousness. The participation of Jesus in this ritual shows us God's desire to be in solidarity with the entire human race. Here, Jesus was anointed with the Holy Spirit as he began his mission of proclaiming salvation for all the nations. It was now time, as it were, for the beginning of "Christmas in action".

And so, we celebrate once more the Baptism of Jesus as the conclusion of the Christmas season. He is consecrated for his mission. He enters into solidarity with us through his Baptism. He now asks us to renew our commitment to fully accept our own baptismal consecration, to do our share in being instruments of God's love and mercy. Will we allow His light to shine in us to draw others to Him?

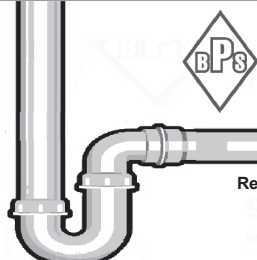
