Breathe in Me

Do we live a life with clarity? Or do we live in darkness? In the Gospel this Sunday (Matthew 4: 12-23), Jesus traveled to Galilee, the most remote part of his country and the furthest from Jerusalem. In Galilee, Jesus began to proclaim the fulfillment of the prophet Isaiah – light has come to the people who lived in darkness.

Each of us knows that the life of every human being has moments of darkness, moments of pain and suffering. Many of the great mystics of our Church, such as St. Teresa of Avila, St. John of the Cross, and St. Teresa of Calcutta, have gone through dark nights that, although purifying, always had a great burden of pain.

Amid the darkness in our lives, Jesus is able to see us with profound clarity. But this relationship with Christ requires effort and sacrifice on our part. With the new life we have in Christ, a new life that began in the waters of baptism, we can have clarity in the midst of the darkness of our lives.

We often do not want to see the reality of our lives or the presence of God in it. If we don't have God's presence with us, if we don't have the light of Christ in our hearts, the shadows of our experiences can be "shadows of death." With the light of Christ, we can be more human. In the light of Christ, we can grow in our humanity, in our spirituality, in our mentality.

The Gospel this Sunday ends with the healing of the sick. This healing is not only physical but also spiritual. We are called to the integral healing of our lives. We are called to conversion. With that, we can continue on our faith journey.

Holy Spirit, Breath of God,

Fill my mind with Your light and my heart with Your peace.

***Dispel the fog of confusion that clouds my thoughts,
and guide me toward the truth that aligns with Your will.***

***Help me to see beyond my fears and doubts,
to recognize the path You have prepared for me.***

***Grant me wisdom to discern what is right,
and courage to follow it with faith and trust.***

***May Your gentle whisper lead me in every decision,
and may my steps be steady in the light of Your presence.***


