Saint Blaise

According to the legendary Acts of Eustratius, Saint Blaise was a physician before he became a Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia. He was a dedicated leader of the Christian community in that city. In the persecution under Licinius and Agricolaus, Governor of Cappadocia, he was imprisoned and died the death of a martyr, probably about 315.

The legend says that he was a great friend and helper of the animals. When hunters found him in a mountainous cave he was kneeling in prayer and wolves, lions and bears were patiently waiting for him and protecting him. From this story the custom to bless water on his feast day developed which was given to sickly cattle and animals to strengthen them. The legend also reports that a woman brought him her son who was at the point of death because a fish bone got stuck in his throat.

In the 9th century his veneration spread also to the West. Saint Blaise was one of the most popular saints in Europe during the Middle Ages. From the 16th century on, there is the custom of giving a special blessing on his feastday: the blessing of throats. The priest or deacon holds two candles that are crossed in form of a Saint Andrew Cross (X) against the head or the throat of the person and says: "Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, may the Lord free you from all evils of the throat and from any other evil, in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen."

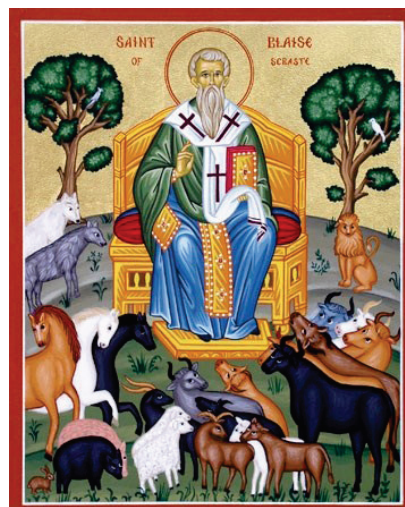

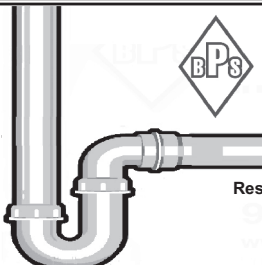

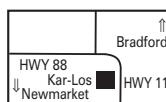
