## A Life that Makes Sense

**Today, on the 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time, a few weeks before we start the holy season of Lent, we hear a part of the Sermon on the Mount in our Gospel today, as Jesus describes what we should strive toward in our life of discipleship. According to Jesus, we are to be the salt of the earth and the light of the world. As disciples of Christ, we are to bring flavor and light to the world around us.**

**Such images are probably very familiar to us as followers of Christ. Jesus calls us to be a light in the darkness of our world. He calls us to change the flavor of our world, to bring a perspective of faith no matter where we are in our lives.**

**It is interesting that both light and salt have a couple of similar characteristics - they don't exist for themselves and they don't draw attention to themselves. We add salt to something like French fries to enhance the flavor of the food. The salt is not the main food that we are eating. And we put on a light in order to see something else. So, if we are a light in the world, we are to be that light so that it will lead others to Jesus. As Christians, we are to shine as a light not so that others will see us, by that they we see a path to the Lord.**

**What are we to give so that our light will shine and that our salt give flavour? The late Pope Francis shared us a clue: 'We must carry the light of Christ with the witness of genuine love. The Christian must be a luminous person who carries the light, a light the comes from one that is not his own, but a gift of God, a gift of Jesus' (Angelus Message, April 9, 2014). He then cautioned: 'If a Christian loses this light, his life doesn't make sense. He is a Christian in name only.'**


