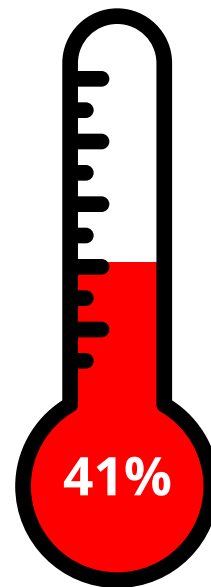

HVAC DONATION PROGRESS

Next weekend there will be a second collection for the building fund.

This collection goes towards **replacing the 3 aging rooftop HVAC units** for the church. The Parish finance & building council has determined after consultation with contractors and industry experts that the HVAC units are the *highest priority project at this time*.

Thank you for your contributions towards the building fund. Because of your generous donations, **we have raised \$49,671.85 towards the \$120,000.00** needed to replace the rooftop units. We are at 41% of our goal!

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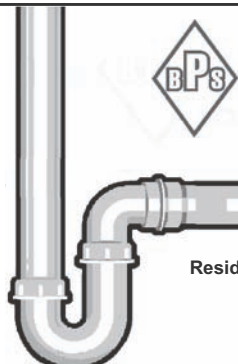
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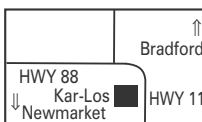
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
