### **Ruminations** ....

Christmas has come and gone. The stores have moved on to Valentine's Day and Spring furniture. The horns and hoopla of New Year's Day have subsided and we are already half way through our first For those numbers nerds, there are only 338 days until Christmas. It's not so much the turning of the calendar pages that are significant, it is the important and memorable dates within those calendars, for better or worse, that bring meaning to the turning of the weeks and months. My second eldest cousin turns 60 in a couple of weeks, which means, since the death of his younger brother 8 years ago, I am next on the list (in a number of years yet). In a couple of weeks we will remember the death of my dad 14 years ago. But perhaps the most pertinent anniversary is the one year mark since we moved mom into her new digs at the long term care facility. It was a brutally hard day, and my brother drew the short straw. He and his wife came up on the Friday morning of her moving day (unknown to her). This was after two episodes of losing her as she began to wander. The crisis call came in that there was an emergency bed ready for her and we had a day to make the decision. So the day before we moved some personal items in to make it seem remotely like home, pictures and bedding and furniture. As much as it seemed deceptive and a betrayal in our hearts, at least our heads knew it was the right decision. I remember watching her leave the rectory on this new and reluctant journey that no one wanted her to take, and it was one she herself dreaded when she was not in dementia. The facility was not unknown to us as my sister-in-law's mother also had been a resident there. It was hard realizing that we were placing her there likely until her own passing. It also precipitated the selling of the only home we had known as a family. Mom's final words of freedom were "well, I guess if my family thinks this is best for me." Mercifully it did not take Mom long to adjust. Spurred on by the speedy descent into dementia it seemed like in half an hour she was making the best of her new surroundings and moving on. It has been way more difficult for us on the outside. There is a bit of consolation in her condition. She is active in the various activities that are offered, a willing participant in the games and activities each day. She has found a friend in a similar condition and the two of them are thick as thieves carrying on non-sensical conversations that



only the two of them can follow or understand. Mom has good days of memory remembering us by name, but other days merely remembering that she should remember us. She is as healthy as can be expected, involved in her new life, and content in her own little world. I guess we can't really ask for more. Happy anniversary mom, we miss you.


