

Ruminations

10,226 days ago it was another mild, spring-like last weekend of January. All the snow had melted and it was unseasonably warm. A carload of us from the seminary had decided to make for the border - Buffalo, not for wings, but for black suits. So the two Cape Bretoners, my brother and I piled into the 'vette', the car that my brother and I shared. Now before you get the wrong impression, it was not a Corvette, but a Chevette. The four of us had been together in the seminary for going on five years at this time, and having survived our big evaluation, miraculously we had been okayed to be ordained deacons. I remember that the main concern about my brother was that he walked down the aisle like a goalie. The seminary formation thought this was a concern, my brother took it as a compliment, because, well, as the formation team should have known, he was indeed a goalie. The customs official was wholly unimpressed as to why we were heading to Buffalo. We had no real destination, no particular store, after all this was long before google and cell phones and GPS. Eventually we found a place and we all purchased these cheap and cheap looking black suits that would get us through the deaconate ordination, all except me. For whatever reason, they had no jackets that would fit my chest. Anyway, just before returning to the boarder, we stopped and everyone changed into their new suits (except me) to cross the Border so we had nothing to declare except the clothes on our back. The ordination was held in St. John's Chapel at the seminary. I think there were seven of us, and I remember my mom had one big complaint. When all the deacon candidates were prostate on the floor was the litany of the saints rang out, from where mom was sitting, she could not see my brother and me. There was another candidate that obscured her view. He had not been in the seminary with us but he was being ordained. He was a huge man, really huge and he blocked the sightline for my mom. We calmed her by reminding her that she got to see the important parts, and that she had seen us lying down many times before. She still remarked that she was ready to call Green Peace to have him hauled back out to sea. The festivities were fairly simple afterwards. Back at mom and dad's there were some finger foods and lots of conversation and laughter. My cousins were up from Nova Scotia and they sat in the wrong place in the Chapel. The ushers heard their accent and assumed they were here for the two Cape Bretoners. They bragged to mom that their view of my brother and I was unobstructed, which only served to get mom's goat. A few weeks later we heard that that fellow was not pro-



ceeding to priesthood and my mom breathed a sigh of relief. For her birthday though, we did buy her a membership to Green Peace.






