

Ruminations

We should have called Sunday at 9:30 "guess who is coming to dinner." I know there is a great difference between hearing theory and watching an event and then having questions about it. In fact, it is a theological principle called mystagogia - reflecting on an experience trying to find meaning in it. This is exactly what those in the RCIA do after every public liturgical event. They think of it in terms of a de-briefing, but what it truly is is sound catechetical pedagogy. So it was with great joy that I answered questions about what happened at the 9:30 am Mass on Sunday when we received five people into our Community through the sacrament of confirmation and welcomed them to our table for the first time. Few questions arose about the three elder candidates, but it seemed that the two young people, both under the age of grade sevens that presented a curve ball to many people. It became an excellent opportunity to present the vision of the Church concerning initiations. There are only two categories for baptism; infants, and those who have reached their 7th year of life (had their 6th birthday) and above. Yes, a six year old is initiated the same way that a 66 year old would be, not like a 6 month old. So just as an adult would be fully initiated, celebrating baptism, confirmation and first Eucharist all at the same celebration, so would the 6 year old. That is just the way the Church does it. Now this Sunday, the five of them were already baptized but in various Protestant The Church rule is that "no greater burden than denominations. necessary is to be placed on them" in welcoming them. That translates as, whenever they are ready, they are received at the earliest convenience. In an ideal parish where there was ample team members to journey with them, they would be on a journey set apart from the RCIA which technically is exclusively for the unbaptized people. Alas, with our limited team, they take on this task as well. It would be wonderful to have people to lead the various stages to welcome the volume of people coming to our community (last year we had 23 at the Easter Vigil, and this year we have similar numbers, not to mention the three new people who approached us last week to join - they just keep coming). Because we have been rather complacent in living the vision of the Church, most parishes have never seen the celebration of baptisms, or first communions, or confirmations, or reception of people into our midst, and yet the very documents governing such liturgies express very strongly that all these rituals belong by right and by meaning within with worshiping assembly that gathers each week. Translate this to mean during regular Sunday worship, because this is precisely why we exist. Without them, we become stagnant and informed about our God-given mission to build the kingdom. Though it may seem an inconvenience at times, at its heart, it is the very Spirit pulsing through our community.



So much to learn about how the Church sees itself, and every time we encounter a new liturgy, our identity grows. Welcome to the five new comers.




