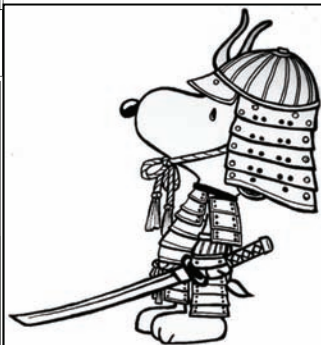

Ruminations

One of my all-time favorite shows was Untamed World. It was a wildlife show and had this incredible African beat music intro that sparked a lifelong fascination with African music. There were other wildlife shows that stirred my appreciation for the wilds of the world. Even still, my favorite television channel is the National Geographic channel, and I watch it far more than any other channel. Since I have this deficiency of wanderlust, I have no real desire for travel. The trip to Algonquin Park is even a bit too far for my liking, and there has to be a real eruption of desire to get away before I will even consider giving in to the mild impulse. I often get asked if I have ever been to the Holy Land and I answer unequivocally yes. I have been to both Banff and Whistler on many occasions, but overseas – absolutely no desire. When pressed about whether or not I would like to go to Europe or the Holy Land, the answer is not really, though I must confess that I studied German in high school for three years in part because I wanted to live in Switzerland when I was growing up. If I ever did travel overseas, and believe the itch is almost non-existent, I think I would like to see Australia and any of the major nature preserves in Africa, either the Serengeti or the Maasai Mara or the Amboseli or the Kruger Game Reserve. Again, if the offer came tomorrow to go to any or all, I would still decline because it is a remote interest at best. Those in my backyard do not elicit wonder and fascination, but scorn and annoyance. Now this is not another wildlife capture adventure story of chipmunks gone wild. Local fauna are fine as long as they stay away from me, and that includes the skunk that lurks around the rectory almost every night, or the possum that scurries away on my walks, and most recently, the coyote that startled me the other night as I opened my back door to take the garbage to the dumpster. He was maybe twenty feet away and merely turned and stared as I opened the door. Now luckily I didn't scream that way I do when a mouse darts across the kitchen floor. I tried hissing him away. Not a budge. So I took a few feint charges in his direction, but he merely took a few steps back. I picked up a gardening tool perfect for hurling like a javelin. All across the parking lot we riposted and parried with that little critter showing way less fear than me. As I balanced my flip flops in this great joust a thought came that maybe this varmint may have rabies. He just refused to vacate the premises. Finally I decided that the best defence is a strong offence and with the spear posed to hurl at him I made a forceful charge, howling like a banshee and chased him off into the car lot where he fled. For the Untamed World, he seemed uncharacteristically tame.
