Ruminations

The first time I experienced Vespers of any sort was the day I moved into the seminary in first year. Part of our orientation was to begin to learn how to use "The Book of Christian Prayer". This book was to become the faithful companion of us through the five years of formation until that day when we were ordained to the deaconate and assumed the responsibility of praying the full breviary every day. Now the single volume Christian prayer condensed the full scope of morning prayer, evening prayer, night prayer, and a limited schedule of the 'mid-prayers', mid-morning, noon, mid-afternoon, and we were instructed where to place them strategically to make life easier, after all, the whole exercise was flipping from one section to another. Here for the psalms, there for the reading, back to the front for the morning canticle or to the back for the evening canticle, back to one of the ribbons for the intentions and the rest of the prayers. It was mind bobbling and confusing, and very humbling. So much so that I wondered if one could be a priest if one couldn't sort out this prayer book. Well, it didn't take that long to master it, and after a couple of weeks with the whole seminary praying it every day, it became second nature. It was rather novel and inspiring joining in the communal recitation of the psalms. There were some days when the feeling of the unity in the rhythm was palpable, and other days Much like all churches, each seminarian had their not so much. particular seat in the chapel. Mine was three pews from the back before the division on the right hand side. It was only a coincidence that this was the closest exit to make it to the dining room for meals. Not really. The seminary experience was rooted in the monastic tradition, prayed in monasteries and convents for centuries. The Divine Office has always been meant to be prayers communally, but the reality of most priests is that it is celebrated alone. There is an older tradition that goes back even further called the cathedral version. My first experience with that felt very foreign and exhilarating. It was at the university of Notre Dame the first time that I attended a liturgy conference there. It began in darkness which eventually gave way to candle glow as everyone lit their taper candles. The psalms were chanted in a hauntingly beautiful way that just lured you into the spirit of the prayer. The whole rhythm spoke of peace and subdued gratitude. The Second Vatican Council highly recommended that the prayer of the Church which included Vespers or evening prayer be restored to the regular repertoire of



parish life. Quite honestly, Vespers is one of those hidden treasures that like no other, attunes us into the very rhythm of day and night, light and darkness, life and death. Even if we don't celebrate as often as the Church envisions, or as often as we could or should, it is wonderful to do it anytime. Join us this weekend and treat your spirit. *Fr. Roy*


