



Ruminations

Shock and disgust were the two emotions that jumped to the fore. No I'm not referring to any of the World Cup Soccer upsets. I'm referring to a nutrition report I had. In the past I have had my hair analyzed and discovered some interesting things happening at the microscopic level of my body. It is more of a mineral analysis, deficiencies and over abundances. 
