### Ruminations ....

I make no bones about the fact that I am a winter person. Beautiful fall days and sunny spring mornings are up there too, but as for summer, other than the extended hours of daylight and the long lingering evenings, I can't say that I am a fan. In the midst of winter blowing and snowfalls, you will never hear me longing for the hot, hazy days of summer. And the past week has only served to re-inforce my stance. I remember pooling money with mom to purchase our first air conditioner for fathers' day back in the mid-seventies from Zellers just after Upper Canada Mall opened. It was beyond a miracle. 


