

I remember going into Toronto for a big event and the crowds and confusion were to overwhelming and busy that if I never made it there again, I could very easily die happy. I have had them elsewhere since, but none have ever compared to the deliciousness of munching on one of them under the warm August sunshine with the carnival atmosphere for a backdrop. For whatever reason, it just epitomized that summer feeling, and with Beach Boys' music ringing out "Good Vibrations" it was great to be there and a great way to mark the end of the summer in anticipation of hitting the books again. It has been years, maybe even over a decade or more



since I last attended. Concerts at the best of times do not appeal to me, and since the Grandstand is no more, something has been lost, but the opening of the CNE also unleashes a flood of innocent, and joyful reminiscences replete with great memories of delicious food samples, ice cream waffles and summer time music. 
