

Ruminations

I feel like I'm training to become a hospital drama script writer. It has been quite a week at the hospital. Mom was finally moved out of emergency onto a floor. The floor is not exactly her section. She is placed on the floor with musculoskeletal ward - people with hip replacements and the like. So the diagnosis was indeed a urinary tract infection, eventually discovered to be caused by a kidney stone that was blocking the fluids from descending normally into the bladder. solution was to insert a stent to bypass the stone. 
