This year's Easter arrives rather late Almost at the last possible date. It means Spring's first full moon occurs mid-April The next Sunday's Easter from a decree that is papal. For centuries now we've celebrated this movable feast A little different than the Christians from the East. For forty or so days we've been in preparation To acknowledge Easter morn as the dawn of our re-creation. Through the death of Jesus and the resurrection of the Christ, Our lives entwined as part of the sacrifice. So Easter begins Thursday upon the sunset With the Holy Three days our identity to whet. We celebrate the best of our liturgical repertory That immerses us in the Christological glory. We start with the Lord's last supper meal Commemorating the new and everlasting covenantal seal.
