Ruminations

It was such a blast to have Dr. Massimo Faggioli here this past weekend. His presentation on the history and spirituality on the Second Vatican Council was extraordinary and something every Catholic should hear. I wish he had taught at the Seminary because it was so life -giving and informative. And the in between times of escorting him from here to there, and dining with him was certainly a highlight of my academic pursuits. There was a friend of his in Toronto whom he wanted to connect with so we made arrangements for him to visit her. She is a fellow academic with a doctorate in Church ecclesiology and she was the ambassador to the Vatican representing the country of Georgia. She wanted to come to Vespers and hear his talk so I arranged to pick her up on Sunday afternoon. I knew where she lived because I had picked Massimo the night before from there. I was going to scoot down and be back before dinner was served at 5 pm. Dr. Tamara was going to join us for the meal, or so I thought. As I was cruising down the 404 signs began to indicate that the Don Valley Parkway was closed. Now I was scheduled to pick her up at 3:30 essentially at Bay and Bloor. There were police and ambulances and firetrucks on both sides of the highway and everything was reduced to single lanes and lots of merging and stopping again. So when we finally reached home, everyone had



eaten and we were two and a half hours overdue, but we made it in time for Vespers. Honestly I have no idea how people can do that day in and day out. I think I have a new appreciation for road rage. And thank God I don't live in Newmarket rush Toronto. hour is more than I can handle.
