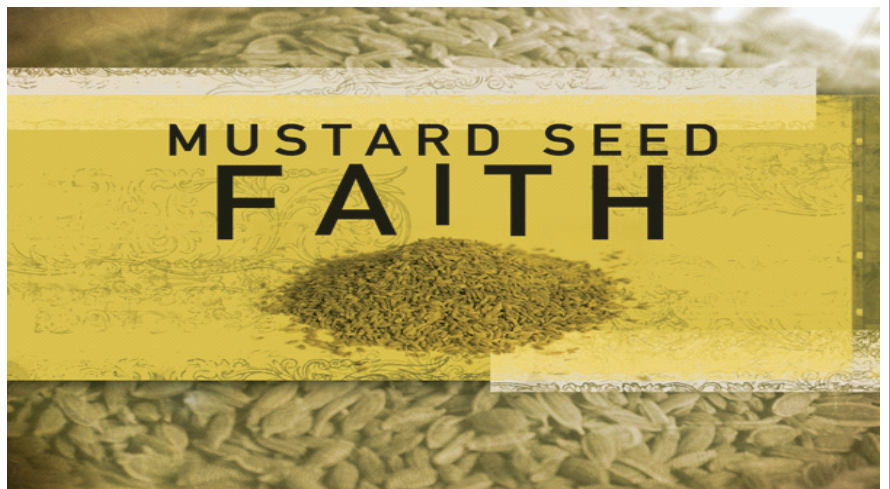

## Ruminations ....

On my latest visit to see my mom, I received a very jarring scare. The experts explained to us that with mom's dementia, she will live on a plateau for an indeterminate amount of time but then she can decline quite rapidly and unpredictably. What that means is that there is very little change in her day to day moods. When people ask me how she is doing, quite honestly there is very little change while she is on a plateau. Just recently mom had to be confined to a wheelchair. During her last stay in the hospital, she lost the strength to stand on her feet. Prior to that she had started to fall and we have several 'raccoon' pictures of the bruising on her face to prove it. As a form of recovery she was being walked around with the help of the workers. The fear though is that she will never be strong enough to walk on her own, or to walk securely. She is a very high risk to fall and her dementia compounds the danger. So the decision was to confine her to a wheelchair that tilts at a certain angle to ensure that mom cannot get out, even though she still tries every once in a while. We had asked about a walker but we were informed that with her dementia, mom is unable to learn a new task like using a walker. It may have been possible if she had learned to walk with one prior to falling into dementia, but I guess it rings true when they say you can't teach an old dog new tricks. When mom first was admitted or moved in as it were, she was very mobile. In fact, she escaped twice walking outside looking for her car. She sent the team there into quite a panic and it was one of the reasons they suggested that mom be moved to a more secure floor. She was much too cagey for them. I remember seeing many of the residents in wheelchairs and mostly sitting in front of the television watching the old movies or listening to old music. Mom didn't have much time for that as she was up and about, cuddling her newest child, her doll which thankfully she never named so there is no reference to him in her will. My youngest brother was quite worried that he was being replaced as the favorite but we assured him he was still the spoiled baby of the family. So the scary thing about my last visit



with mom was the music that they had wafting through the facility – the geriatric muzak. It was so pleasant to listen to but then it dawned on me, this music that meant to calm and settle these older dementia people in familiar sounds and songs that strike a cord, were songs that were utterly familiar to me, from my era of music listening. I started to fear that they were playing my songs. So I started to scout out rooms that I might like, just in case.
