

Ruminations....

It is hard to believe how quickly Christmas comes and goes. Kind of the final act dismantling and finding storage space for the growing nativity display. As the number of nativities grows and the display itself becomes more elaborate, the storage becomes a premium. In all it took about 8 hours of taking down and packaging each display, and that was with several hands helping. The almost final work was hauling the brick structure back into the garage, but there was a bit of an enviable problem. There is no room at the inn, or should I say, no room behind the altar. With the fire inspection pending, and fire code compliance, the furnace room which had become the dump and store go to place has now lost its place as the store-all. As we struggle to find new nooks and crannies to convert to storage, everything comes under scrutiny. Do we need this or that? Can it be stored somewhere else? Somehow else? Does Fr. Roy really need his office that badly? One of the items under suspicion is the old church bell from Our Lady of Good Counsel mission church in Sharon. It is stashed behind the altar and comes out on occasion when O.L.G.C. school comes for mass, or when one of the parishioners from the old Sharon community is having a funeral mass. So talks about finding a permanent home somewhere on the premises have started, but are very far from a decision. The rectory has been under renovations for a bit and they are still on-going. As a consequence, the Christmas decorations never got put up. The good thing about it is that it is easy to clean up and that post decoration bareness is not in effect. That doesn't mean that the house was totally without adornment. Some of the house decorations were used to help festoon the hall for the ministries wine and cheese. At the end of the wine and cheese all those decorations were wheeled back into the rectory and semi-placed at strategic locations to give a semblance of festivity. They are still there as we speak and will likely still be there until at least February second, the unofficial end of the Christmas season, forty days after Christmas day and is celebrated as the feast of the Presentation of Jesus. After that, because of the issue of storage, they may remain out all year round, becoming at various times, Valentine's decorations, St. Patrick's Day trees, Easter lights, Easter trees, Canada Day trees, Thanksgiving lights, Hallowe'en lights and finally Christmas once again. Sounds like a plan to me. There are still odds and ends waiting to find a place to rest until next December 18 when we start to re-assemble the nativity sets and erect the trees.



The three hundred and thirty-four days until then, if the present lightning speed of time is any indication, will fly by and we will start the cycle again. The good news is that a friend of mine has already found a new nativity hade in the Czech Republic to add to the collection. If only we could find room at the inn.




